

COVID-19 TRAVEL ALERTS

•**Covid-19 Test or Vaccination Required:** Passengers aged 12 years or older must hold one of the following:

- a negative result of a biological examination of virological screening (RT-PCR, PCR, qRT-PCR, qPCR, RT-LAMP, LAMP, TMA, antigen or detection of RNA only) or a biological test enabling the detection of the N protein of SARS-COV-2 where the test is carried out less than 72 hours before the flight. Please note that negative test results issued by the National Health Service (NHS) in the United Kingdom or by HSE (Irish Health Service) in Ireland are not accepted for travel;
- a Covid-19 vaccination certificate demonstrating that at least 28 days have elapsed since the first dose of Janssen vaccine or 7 days have elapsed since the second dose of the Pfizer-Biontech, AstraZeneca, Covishield, Moderna, R-Covi (R-Pharm) or "Covid-19 Vaccine" (Fiocruz) vaccine or 7 days since the first dose of these vaccines if the passenger holds proof that they previously have been infected with Covid-19, and minors accompanying one or more vaccinated adult passengers; or
- a certificate of recovery with a positive test result obtained between 11 days and 6 months before travel proving that they have recovered from Covid-19.

This does not apply to:

- Passengers holding a consular pass issued by a French embassy or consulate. These passengers will be subject to a test on arrival and must quarantine for 7 days in designated establishments;
- Transit passengers;
- Crew members or personnel necessary for operation of passenger or cargo flights (including when travelling as passengers to or from their departure base);
- Members of diplomatic/official delegation, and staff of international organisations with offices located in France (including their spouses and children);
- Passengers travelling on work-related trips, provided that the urgent or frequent nature of the work-related trips have made them incompatible with these tests.

•**Covid-19 Form Required:** Passengers are not permitted to travel if they do not hold a [Sworn Statement](#) that they do not have Covid-19. The statement is available in French and English.

•Covid-19 Mask Required: All passengers are required to wear a surgical mask (or a filtering face piece mask FFP1, FFP2 or FFP3) in the airport and during their flight. Passengers may be denied boarding if not wearing a surgical mask.
